Entry Information and Payments

- Submit entries on Poultry Hub. Entry deadline: April 24, 2026. No exceptions permitted.
- Mail-in entries must be postmarked by April 18, 2026.

- We accept cash, PayPal, and checks for entry fees. Make checks payable to Volunteer State Poultry Club or VSPC.
- PayPal payments may be sent to vspoultryclub@gmail.com. Any applicable PayPal processing fees are the responsibility of the exhibitor or donor.
- Printable paper entry forms are available in this catalog.
- Optional VSPC membership dues may also be added during Poultry Hub registration.

Health Requirements

- The State of Tennessee requires Pullorum and H5/H7 testing. Upload a copy of your NPIP documents to Poultry Hub.
- No birds will be allowed to enter the show hall without being NPIP certified or tested by the state tester.
- The state tester will be available on Saturday at 6:00 a.m.

Birds will be released immediately following the awards presentation. No birds will be released before the awards presentation is over.

Inside and Outside Sale Areas

- Exhibition sale cages are available to exhibitors only on a first-come, first-served basis. Bantam Sale Cages (3 bird limit) and Large Fowl Sale Cages (3 bird limit) are \$5.00 each and should be reserved through the entry process. If entries exceed cage availability, priority be given to accommodate show birds, which could make sales cages extremely limited or unavailable. We will do our best to give enough advance notice as soon as we know. Please follow our Facebook event page if an alternate sales plan is needed. If this is the case refunds will be issued.
- Exhibitors should bring their own cage cups to provide feed and water for sale birds.
- An Outside Sales pass is \$10.00 for current VSPC members and \$20.00 for non-members on a first-come, first-served basis.
- The outside sales area is in a designated parking lot at the fairgrounds, separate from the pavilion. There will be both an NPIP area and a non-NPIP area. Non-poultry-related vendors are welcome. - The age limit is 6-18 years of age.
- Junior exhibitors must coop in their own birds. If assistance is needed, the club will provide it.

Show Rules

1. All recognized and non-standard varieties of large fowl, bantams, and waterfowl are accepted in the show.
2. Open class entries are \$7.00 per bird. Junior class entries are \$5.00 per bird. Double coop entries are charged at double the regular single entry rate: Open double coop entries are \$14.00 per bird, and Junior double coop entries are \$10.00 per bird.
3. No entries will be accepted through Facebook Messenger.
4. Exhibitors holding NPIP certifications may place birds in their coops on Friday, May 1, from 4:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m. Non-NPIP birds will be tested by the state beginning Saturday, May 2, at 6:00 a.m. All birds must be in their coops by 8:45 a.m. on judging day.
5. All entries must be paid before cooping birds.
6. All birds will be judged by APA and ABA rules, whichever applies.
7. Judges' decisions are final unless there is a written protest in accordance with APA and ABA rules.
8. Only show officials are allowed in the aisles during judging. Do not disturb or distract judges until the class has been completed.
9. Volunteer State Poultry Club will take every precaution against loss or mishap, but will not be held responsible should any occur.
10. No alcoholic beverages are allowed in the showroom or on the fairgrounds.
11. No smoking is allowed in the showroom.
12. All entries are non-refundable.
13. VSPC will place a reasonable amount of bedding in the show coops. If extra bedding is needed, the exhibitor must provide it.
14. The Show Committee has final jurisdiction in all matters.
15. Inside sales are limited to exhibitors only. Bantam Sale Cages (3 bird limit) and Largefowl Sale Cages (3 bird limit) are \$5.00 each. Outside sales permits are \$10.00 for current VSPC members and \$20.00 for non-members.
16. Please remove water cups and coop cards when cooping out.
17. Exhibits will be handled only by the owner, the judge, the steward, or show officials.
18. Any birds showing signs of sickness will be removed immediately.
19. VSPC is not responsible for the health of birds exhibited or purchased at the show.
20. VSPC is responsible only for the awards the club offers and for the APA/ABA show reports.
21. If a coop is locked, the lock must be removed 10 minutes prior to judging or the bird will not be judged.
22. No tar paper or dividers above the cages. Clear dividers only in between cages.
23. There will be no cooping out before final judging. Please respect the other exhibitors and coop out after the awards presentation.
24. A \$5.00 clean up fee will be added through Poultry Hub registration. Because Poultry Hub does not currently allow this fee to be limited by exhibitor type, all exhibitors will see the charge during registration. Junior exhibitors will receive a \$5.00 cash refund in their exhibitor package at check-in.
25. All matters not addressed by these rules or by ABA/APA guidance will be at the discretion of the Superintendent, Show Secretary, or Show Coordinator.
